WHEREAS, Cass Township Board of Supervisors, Schuylkill County, Pennsylvania intends to enforce the Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code (the "Code"), a statue established by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to establish certain minimum standards of construction; and,

WHEREAS, to properly implement the Code and to assist in determining the proper construction techniques needed within the Cass Township geographic area, Cass Township must adopt a Resolution establishing certain climatic and geographic design criteria:

- 1. Supervisors establish climatic and geographic design criteria as follows:
 - a. Ground snow load
 - i. Use 50 psf for elevations above 1280' Mean Sea Elevation .
 - ii. Use 40 psf for elevations less than or equal to 1280' (MSE)
 - b. Wind Speed 90 miles per hour
 - c. Seismic Design Categories B
 - d. Construction subject to damage from:
 - i. Weathering Severe
 - ii. Frost Depth Line 42 inches
 - iii. Termite Moderate to Heavy
 - iv. Decay Slight to Moderate
 - e. Winter Design Temperature 7
 - f. Ice Shield Underlayment Required Yes
 - g. Air Freezing Index 1000
 - h. Mean Annual Temperature 47
- 2. Chapter 3 of the Building, Planning an Construction Code, Section R301 "Design Criteria" together with Table R301.2(1) attached hereto and forming a part hereof and all references therein are hereby incorporated into this resolution by reference. The Township shall be authorized to change the aforementioned categories if further evidence becomes available.
